## FIRE DRILL

Steps to take in the fire drill:

- 1. Write down the time you start on a piece of paper.
- 2. Set off a smoke alarm, or yell fire. You will pretend there is a real fire.
- 3. Announce the location of the fire (so everyone knows which exit to use and which direction is not safe)
- 4. Evacuate the residents to the designated safe location outside of the home.
- 5. Write down the time everyone is safely evacuated from the home.
- 6. Fill out the fire drill form and keep it in your caregiver notebook.
